(1) Meeting held on 07 December 2021

ATR

1. Charting out plan of action: The IQAC had a discussion among the team members and charted out the plan of action for 2021-22 as follows and submitted to the principal.

Plan of action for 2021-22

To update website and increase % of ICT-enabled teaching

To exhort the faculty for organizing seminars and workshops in collaboration with other institutions

To encourage faculty and students to join online certificate courses

To request the departments to increase field-based activities for the students

To pursue philanthropists and donors for financial contribution towards newly sanctioned B.Sc. courses as the posts are not sanctioned.

- 2. Action Plan for III-phase admissions: Admissions committee was constituted with the following members to monitor and enhance admissions.

The committee chalked out a plan of action to visit the neighboring Junior colleges and motivate the students to join in the college. After completion of II-phase admissions, the committee members visited the neighboring villages to motivate the left over students to join in the college.

- 3. Submission of AQAR: Taking inputs from the departments, committees, library, office and the principal, the IQAC team prepared AQAR for 2020-21 and after approval by the principal, submitted it to NAAC in online mode.
- 4. Bridge Courses: All the departments conducted bridge courses for the new students for a period ranging from one week to ten days on the topics selected for the purpose.
- 5. Meeting Philanthropists: The Principal and the staff members met philanthropists in Bhimavaram and sought financial help for smooth conduct of newly introduced science courses from the A.Y 2021-22.

6. Academic calendar & Annual curricular plans: As the college is an affiliated college, the IQAC has recommended that the university academic calendar be implemented as it is, and directed all the departments to prepare curricular plans for the two semesters in accordance with this. The curricular plans were approved after careful examination and sent to the head of the institution.

(2) Meeting held on 15 March 2021

- 1. Review of departmental Action Plans: Action Plans prepared by various departments were reviewed by IQAC and necessary suggestions were made regarding inclusion of more student centric activities like student seminars, community service projects, project works etc.
- 2. Use of ICT in assessment: Google forms were used by all the Departments to conduct online quizzes as a part of formative assessment and Continuous Internal Evaluation as insisted by Commissioner of Collegiate Education. Kahoot.Com, Plickers etc. were used by Commerce Department along with Google forma for formative assessment.
- 3. Review of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities: All the Departments conducted various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities as mentioned in the University curriculum and as initiated by the IQAC.
- 4. Class work for newly introduced science courses: Class in-charge for newly introduced Science courses were appointed. Guest faculty on the basis of minimal honorarium were engaged for Maths, Physics, Computer Science, Botany, Zoology and Chemistry subjects. Practices in these subjects were conducted with the help of B V Raju College and Browining College, Bhimavaram. MOUs regarding exchange of science faculty were executed with B V Raju College, Bhimavaram, Browining College, Bhimavaram, and Sri DNR GDC (W), Palakollu.
- 5. Alumni association meeting: Alumni association meeting was conducted in the college and the Alumni members came forward to extend financial cooperation for newly sanctioned science courses.
- 6. Enrollment in N-LIST: All most all the staff and students were enrolled in N-LIST.
